All mountaineering and ski courses in the Alps are led by qualified IFMGA Mountain Guides who are bilingual in English and French. The trekking and snowshoeing courses in the Alps are led by UIMLA International Mountain Leaders. Our guiding team have a vast local knowledge of routes, conditions, and weather systems. Rest assured that you are led by the very best! The guides are supported by our Chamonix hosts who are on hand to assist you throughout your stay.

Our Environmental and Porter Protection policies

We plan our itineraries to minimise our carbon footprint. All of our expeditions and courses are designed to be sensitive to the local economy, and we ensure that all local staff that are hired (drivers, cooks, porters etc) are suitably trained, clothed, paid and looked after. We are committed to this through our close links with porter protection schemes in Nepal and Kilimanjaro. We aim to leave all mountains in a better and cleaner state than we found them originally.

Financial protection and how to book securely online

All bookings are financially protected through our bonding with ATOL and the Travel Trust Association. Icicle follows their strict code of practice, and all monies that you pay are held in trust until after your course has ended. You can book securely online, and will receive full confirmation with a Course Information Booklet, detailed equipment lists and training advice.

In the mountains as a solo traveller or couple?

The vast majority of our course accommodation is in twin or double rooms. If you are travelling on your own with lcicle, you will stay in shared accommodation. You do not pay additional supplements for travelling on your own, unless you opt for a single room. Extra nights on either end of the course cost £20pppn. Couples / 2 people booking together are upgraded to a twin / double room wherever possible for no extra charge.









Ski Touring and Off Piste

Avalanche Awareness & Snow Safety Days

Avalanche prediction, route choice, islands of safety, trigger points, and tranceiver search patterns. Dig snow pits and perform rutschblock tests to assess snow stability.

Dates: every day during the winter season (min 2 people). Price: from £49 (equipment included).

Vallée Blanche - Chamonix, legendary 23km off piste

The classic off piste run is a must for all skiers / boarders from Aiguille du Midi at 3842m. Your guide will take you down the most challenging route for your off piste ski ability.

Skills: Black runs on-piste. Price: £280 for up to 4 people, £10 extra per person to 6 max. Inc. safety kit.

Chamonix Off Piste: Level 1 'Adventure' Clinic

Experience the best conditions for fresh tracks and thrilling descents. This level is for those who have skied between the pistes or done a little off piste, who want some more! Popular descents are the Vallée Blanche, the Grands Montets bowl, and Plan d'Aiguille.

Chamonix Off Piste: Level 2 'Performance' Clinic

Designed for skiers with at least a week of previous off piste experience, the focus is on techniques for all mountain skiing. This course will take your skiing to the next level. Ski the Chamonix classics; Pas de Chevre, Italian Bowl, Le Tour gullies, and Courmayeur.

Sunday: briefings & kit checks, Monday to Friday: off piste descents & technique development (1:6), Saturday: debrief. Price: £599 (includes Chamonix centre accommodation). Dates: 7 - 13 Feb 2010, 7 - 13 March 2010, 28 Mar - 3 Apr 2010.

Verbier Off Piste with heliskiing option

The bowls and slopes around Verbier offer great off piste. Five days off piste instruction. Option of a day heliskiing on the Saturday after the course on the Gran Combin.

Zermatt has brilliant linked lift access, steep couloirs, stunning views and deep powder. During the week you will ski the Cervinia (Italy) side as well to explore all the off piste.

Gran Paradiso Tour

A relatively undiscovered gem! Ski through the Gran Paradiso Park, and experience gourmet food in the comfy mountain huts. You also summit and ski the Gran Paradiso 4061m, the highest peak in Italy.

Sunday: briefings & kit checks, Monday to Friday: five days ski touring, with four nights in huts (1:6). Saturday: debrief. Price: £849 (inc. 4 hut nights). Dates: 28 Mar - 3 Apr 2010, 18 - 24 April 2010.

Silvretta Alps Ski Tour

The Silvretta Alps on the border of Switzerland and Austria offer many 3000m summits, including Piz Buin. If you only have a few days touring experience, the terrain is perfect for improving skills. The huts are infamous for great food and showers!

Sunday: briefings & kit checks, Monday to Friday: ski touring and ascents in the Austrian / Swiss border area of the Silvretta Alps (1:6), Saturday: debrief. Price: £899 (inc. 4 nights half board in huts). Dates: 21 - 27 February 2010, 14 - 20 March 2010.

Haute Route, ski tour from Chamonix to Zermatt

The Haute Route is the most famous ski tour in the Alps, traversing 114 miles to Zermatt over a week. Each night you stay half board in mountain huts. You require previous ski touring experience, such as the Introduction Ski Tour weekends or the Silvretta Ski Tour.

Bernese Oberland Ski Tour

This tour tackles several ski mountaineering peaks including the Gross-Wannenhorn 3905m and the Mittaghorn 3143m, and the infamous glacier descent down to Munster. It is an ideal alternative to the Chamonix Zermatt Haute route, and famed for good snow.

Sunday: briefings & kit checks, Monday to Friday: ski touring and ascents in the Oberland region (1:6), Saturday: debrief. Price: £899 (includes 4 nights half board in huts). Dates: 21 - 27 March 2010, 11 - 17 April 2010. Extra dates run for groups.

Monte Rosa 4000ers Ski Tour, Zermatt region

Monte Rosa has the largest land area in the Alps over 4000m, so keeps its snow well, and is great for peak bagging. Stay a night in the Margherita hut, the highest in the Alps.

Sunday: briefing, Mon to Fri: ski tour (1:6), Saturday: debrief. Price: £849 (inc. huts). Dates: 4 - 10 April, 25 April - 1 May 2010.

Winter Ski Ascent of Mont Blanc 4810m course

A week long course to prepare you technically and to acclimatise before skiing Mont Blanc, and descending the North face from the summit or Vallot refuge to Chamonix.

Introduction 4000m 'Summits & Skills'

This course teaches a complete novice the skills needed for the Alps, including glacier travel, ropework, ice and rock skills, navigation, and crevasse rescue. You spend a night in a mountain hut, have an Alpine start for a route, and ascend Gran Paradiso 4061m. By the end of the week you will have climbed vertical ice, gained a navigation award, led a rock route, and climbed a 4000m mountain. Not a bad effort for your first Alpine trip!

Sun: briefings & kit checks, Mon: skills & navigation (1:6), Tue: glacier travel & ice climbing (1:6), Wed: mountaineering (1:6), Thu: climbs & ascent to hut (1:3), Fri: Gran Paradiso (1:3), Sat: debrief. Alpine Autonomy Course

If you have previous climbing or crampon experience, and want a fast track course that is designed to make you more autonomous in the Alps, this is the course for you. You cover the technical syllabus of the Introduction course in greater detail. At the end of the week you traverse the Domes du Miages. We aren't scared of making you autonomous.

Sun: briefings & kit checks. Mon: glacier travel & ice climbing (1:6). Tue: mountaineering ridge climb (1:3). Wed: altitude snow route (1:3). Thu: glacier trek to mountain hut (1:3). Fri: traverse Domes du Miages (1:3). Sat: debrief. Price: £899. Mont Blanc 4810m

Our most popular course tackles the highest mountain in the Alps. We summit by either the Traverse or the Aiguille du Gouter. We have carefully designed our itinerary to help you acclimatise, and to offer several summit weather windows. Our itinerary is deliberately flexible to maximise your summit chances, & preparation routes may include Cosmiques Arête, Gran Paradiso, or the Petite Verte. You should be in great physical shape for Mont Blanc, as the climb involves over 1300m ascent on snow, and your determination will be tested to the limit. Any previous mountain experience you have will be most beneficial.

Sun: briefings & kit checks, Mon: glacier skills and ice climbing (1:6), Tue - Wed: routes & summits, optional night in hut (1:2), Thu: ascend to Mont Blanc hut (1:2), Fri: summit Mont Blanc (1:2), Sat: debrief. Mont Blanc Achievements / Mont Blanc Intermediate

These two week courses have excellent summiting records as you are fully acclimatised.

Grandes Jorasses, the Walker Spur

The North Face of the Grandes Jorasses is in an amazing amphitheatre of some of the most notorious routes in the world, and none are more famous than the Walker Spur which takes almost a plumb line from the highest point. Descend into Italian Val Ferret.

Duration: 7 days (5 days 1:1 Guiding). Previous Skills: rock to 6a, aid to A1, ice to V, excellent ropework, very competent on Alpine D+ / TD / ED grade routes, Scottish grade VI Ice, UK E2 rock. Price: £2499 (Walker Spur), or £1999 (Normal Route).

Paragliding Tandem Flights, Courses & Mont Blanc

Take to the skies over Chamonix! Many people book a tandem flight on the Saturday after their Icicle course, and these last around 30 minutes. If you want to learn to fly solo, we offer a course which runs over a week with ground canopy control, and solo flights with radio contact. We offer tandem flights in September from the summit of Mont Blanc.

Chamonix Alpine Trail Running Courses

Classic Alpine & Via Ferrata

Chamonix Technical Ice & Classics

This course tackles a mixture of famous snow, rock, ice and mixed routes of AD+ or D grades, such as Dent du Geant, the Rochefort Arête, Chere Couloir, or the Moine. The exact choice of routes will take into account your ability, aspirations, and the conditions. You use cable cars to keep the walk-ins to a minimum, to maximise your climbing time.

Sunday: briefings & kit checks, Monday to Friday: technical ascents (1:2), Saturday: debrief. Price: £999 (inc. 1 night in a hut). Dates: 27 June - 3 July 2010, 25 - 31 July 2010, 22 - 28 August 2010, 29 August - 4 September 10, 12 - 18 September 2010.

Summer Alpine North Faces

If you are looking for a technical snow or ice route to ascend a classic summit in the summer, this course will provide the ultimate challenge. Routes often attempted include North Face of Tour Ronde, North Face of Gran Paradiso, Chere Couloir, or Col Copt.

Sunday: briefings & kit checks, Monday to Friday: technical ascents, classic routes & summits, with a night in a hut (1:2), Saturday: debrief. Price: £999 (inc. 1 night half board in a remote mountain hut). Dates: 6 - 12 June 2010, 13 - 19 June 2010.

Three Countries - Three 4000m Summits

If you have done an Intro course, but don't feel ready for a Classics course, this week is at an intermediate level and is great fun! Climb three 4000m summits in three countries; Gran Paradiso (Italy), Mont Blanc du Tacul (France) and the Breithorn (Switzerland).

Zermatt Climber, Technical Alpinism

Welcome to the granite pillars and faces that overlook Chamonix. The infamous routes include: Arête des Papillons, Frison Roche, Chapelle de la Gliere, or Rebuffat on Midi. Advance your technical skills and grades on different styles of rock. If you have visited Chamonix before, you won't repeat anything, as there are 4000 routes to choose from!

Summer & Winter 1:1 Advanced Alpine

Clients looking for 1:1 guiding have a range of different skills and aspirations, and so this course is tailored individually. Previous clients have climbed famous routes such as the Grand Capucin, the Petit Jorasses, Chardonnet, and the Frontier Ridge of Mont Maudit.

Sunday: briefings & kit checks, Monday to Friday: technical ascents (1:1), Saturday: debrief. Price: £1699. If you are looking to ascend harder routes (e.g. Brouillard Arête), book this course and pay a supplement if conditions allow. Dates: on demand.

Chamonix Intro Via Ferrata, Haute Savoie


Designed as access into the mountains for soldiers during the war, via ferrata has now become a popular sport in its own right. This week is aimed at beginners on via ferrata, and is carefully designed to develop your skills. Based in Chamonix, you are led by qualified leaders and guides, so are in the best of hands. Key features of this course are the small group sizes, and the free loan of via ferrata safety kit.

Sunday: briefings, Monday to Friday: via ferrata days with option of night in hut (1:6), Saturday: debrief. Price: £699, inc. Chamonix B&B. Dates: 4 - 10 July 2010, 25 - 31 July 2010, 22 - 28 August 2010.

Bochette Way Via Ferrata

As seen in the 'Cliffhanger' film, these classic via ferrata are set high in the Dolomites of north Italy. They should only be undertaken by those with previous via ferrata or some basic climbing experience. No routes are particularly difficult, but it is continuous, exposed and sustained. Led by a qualified IFMGA Mountain Guide.

Sunday: briefings, Monday - Friday: guided via ferrata ascents (1:6), Saturday: debrief. Price: £999, inc. 6 nights half board in mountain huts. Dates: 1 - 7 Aug 2010, 29 Aug - 4 Sept 2010. Extra dates can be organised throughout the summer for groups of 4 or more.





Switzerland Alpine Classics

The Eiger 3970m: Mittileggi Ridge

The Mittileggi ridge offers competent Alpinists a hard and very exposed climb, as it runs along the edge of the North Face. Before this course you should have good experience such as the Hornli Arête of the Matterhorn or other classic AD / D graded Alpine routes.

Summer Matterhorn 4478m: Hornli Arête

On this mountain your balance and ability with exposure are key. You prepare by ascending classic Chamonix routes such as Dent du Geant or the Rochefort Arête. We maximise your chance of summit success on the Matterhorn, using a 1:1 guide ratio.

Monte Rosa 4000ers

This area is peppered with 4000m peaks and your aim is to ascend as many as possible. You stay in huts including the Margherita hut, which is the highest refuge in the Alps.

Sun: briefings & kit checks, Mon-Fri: five ascent days, 1:2 guiding, Sat: debrief. Price: £1199 (inc. four nights huts). Dates: 20 - 26 June 10, 18 - 24 July 10, 15 - 21 August 10, 29 Aug - 4 Sept 2010.

Oberland 4000ers

Five days of summits in Oberland, including Monch, Jungfrau and the Finsteraarhorn. Nights in refuges.

Summer & Winter Acclimatisation Weekends



Trekking and Snowshoeing

Tour du Mont Blanc (the TMB)

Icicle is a genuine specialist in the Tour du Mont Blanc (TMB), as we have groups on it nearly every week of the summer season from early June through to late September. The TMB is the legendary 180km circuit of Mont Blanc. This is one of the world's finest circular treks, visiting France, Italy and Switzerland. We offer the TMB over three time scales; in ten, six or three days trekking. We also offer a self-guided TMB, and provide detailed route cards, maps and good logistical support. All nights spent in mountain huts.

Summer Walkers Haute Route, Chamonix to Zermatt

This famous trek links the two Alpine capitals of Chamonix and Zermatt. The nights are spent in comfy mountain huts, so this course will really appeal to a keen hillwalker who wants to get away from it all, with six days trekking in spectacular Alpine scenery.
